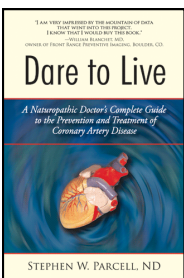
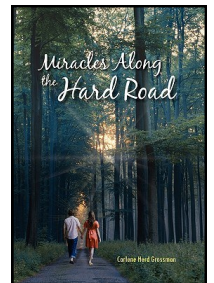


An Afternoon with Local Authors

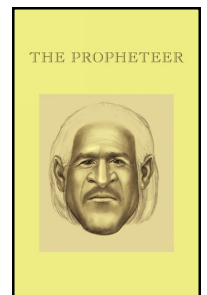
Dr. Steve Parcell, author of *Dare to Live* •

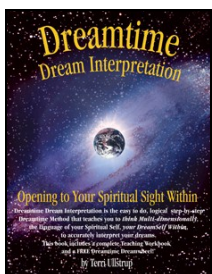
Jason Coe, author of *The Propheteer* •
